

Deaths 349,095 5,581 (24 hrs)





- 71% customized for local needs





Graphs represent in gueue, active or completed calls between the hours of 5/14/2020 and 5/27/2020 11:59:59 PM 🔀









Graphs represent in queue, active or completed calls between the hours of 5/14/2020 and 5/27/2020 11:59:59 PM 💽







Graphs represent in queue, active or completed calls between the hours of 3/1/2020 and 5/27/2020 11:59:59 PM 💽







Graphs represent in queue, active or completed calls between the hours of 3/1/2020 and 5/27/2020 11:59:59 PM 🔂






COVID-19 Calls



FirstWatch COVID-19 Combined Calls Month over Month




Flu Respiratory Calls

Flu Non-Resp Calls


