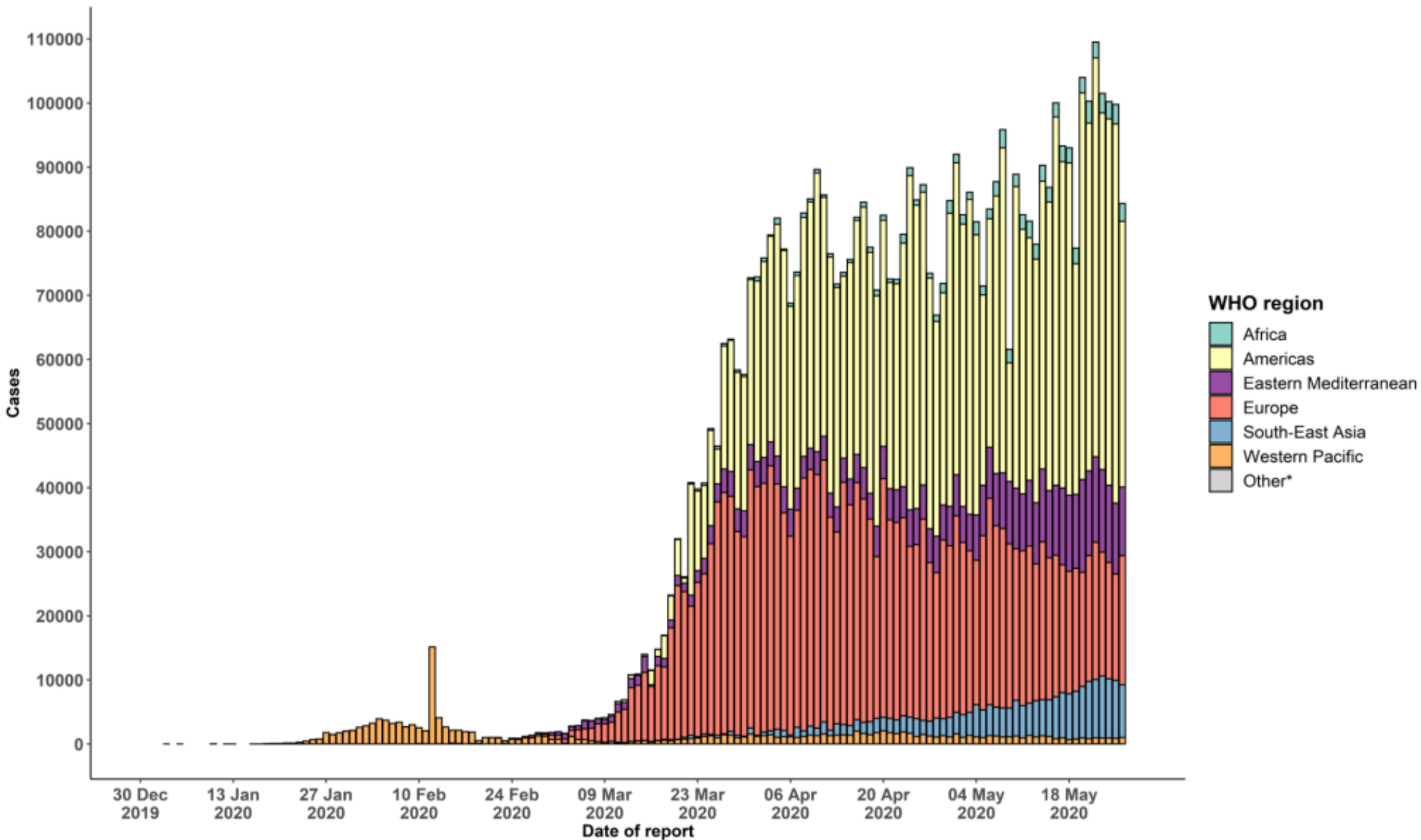

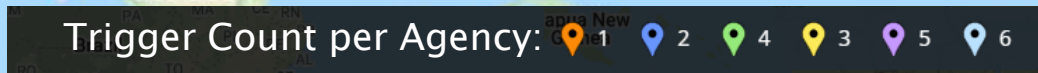

 - 71% customized for local needs

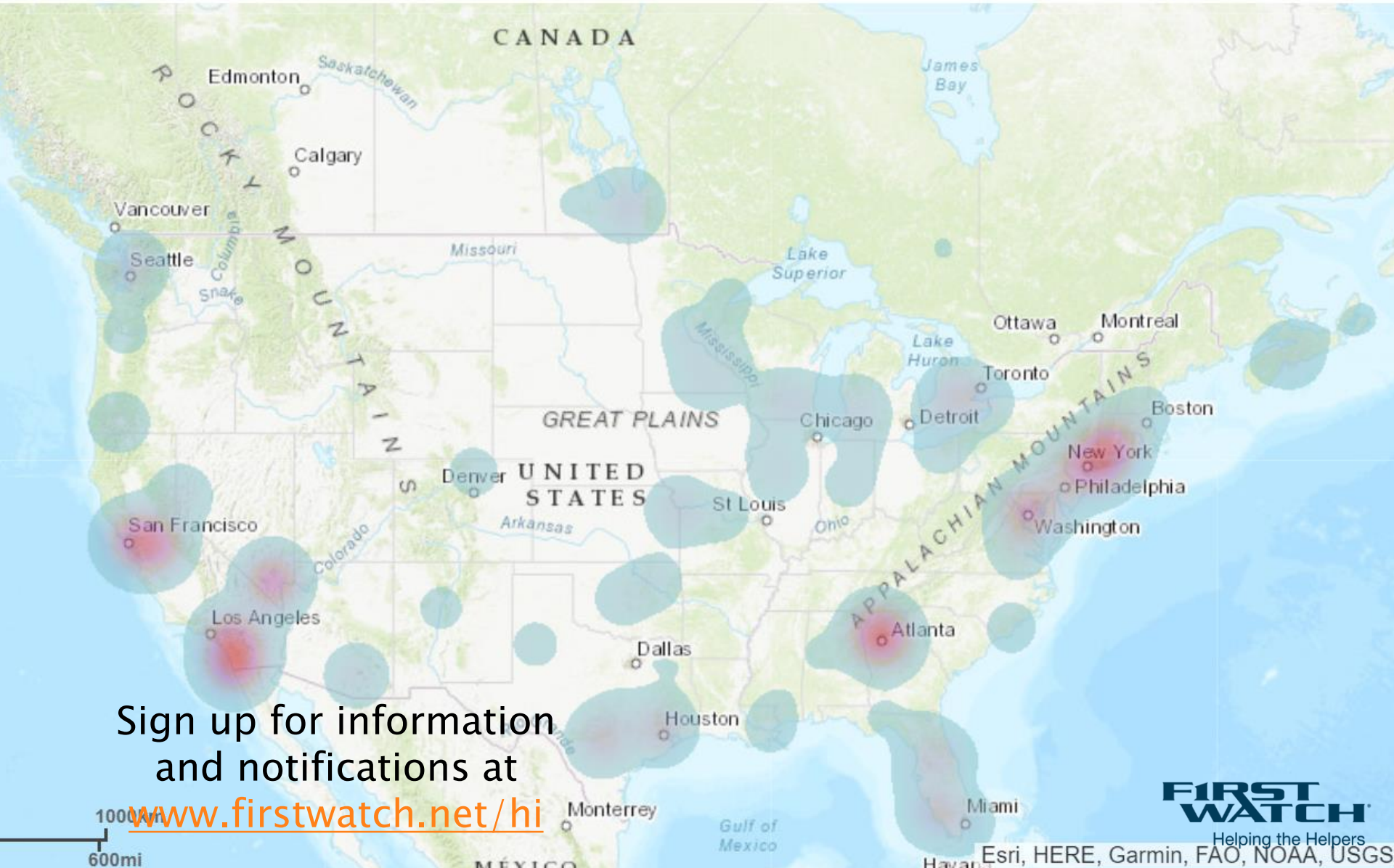

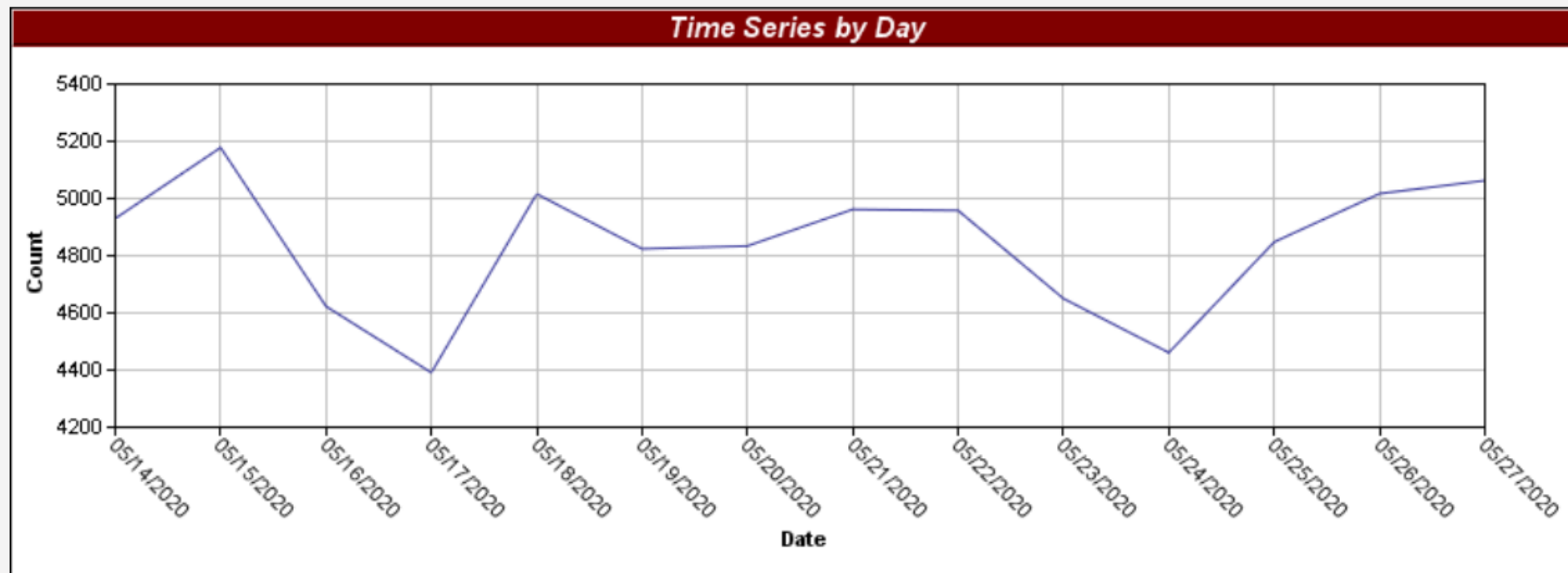

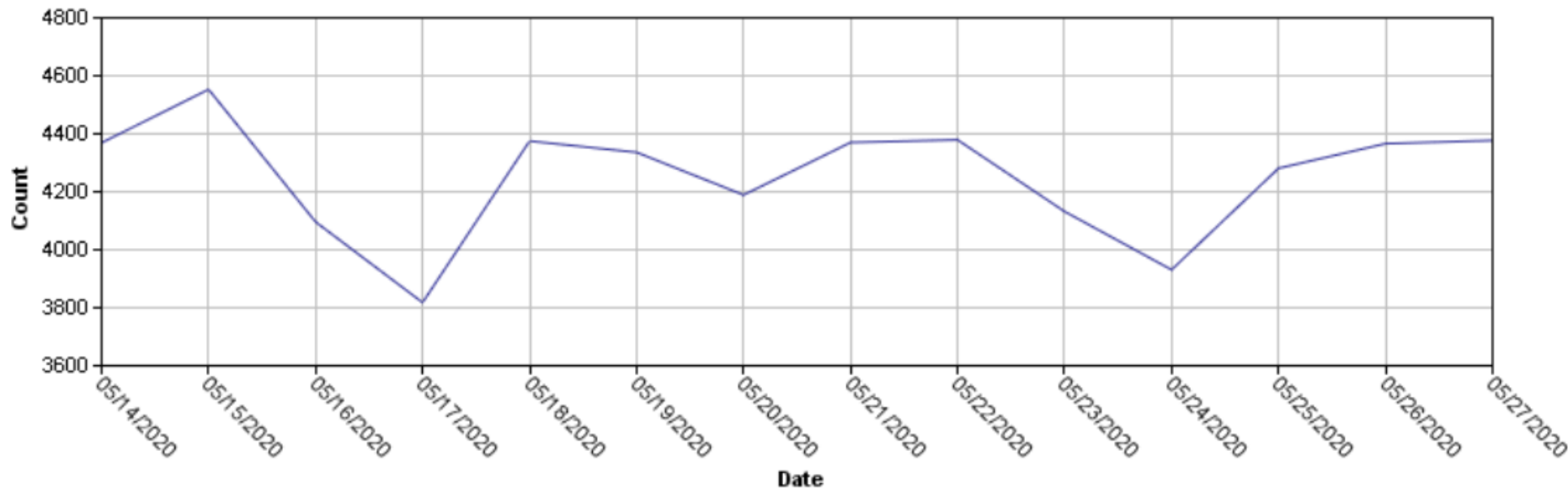

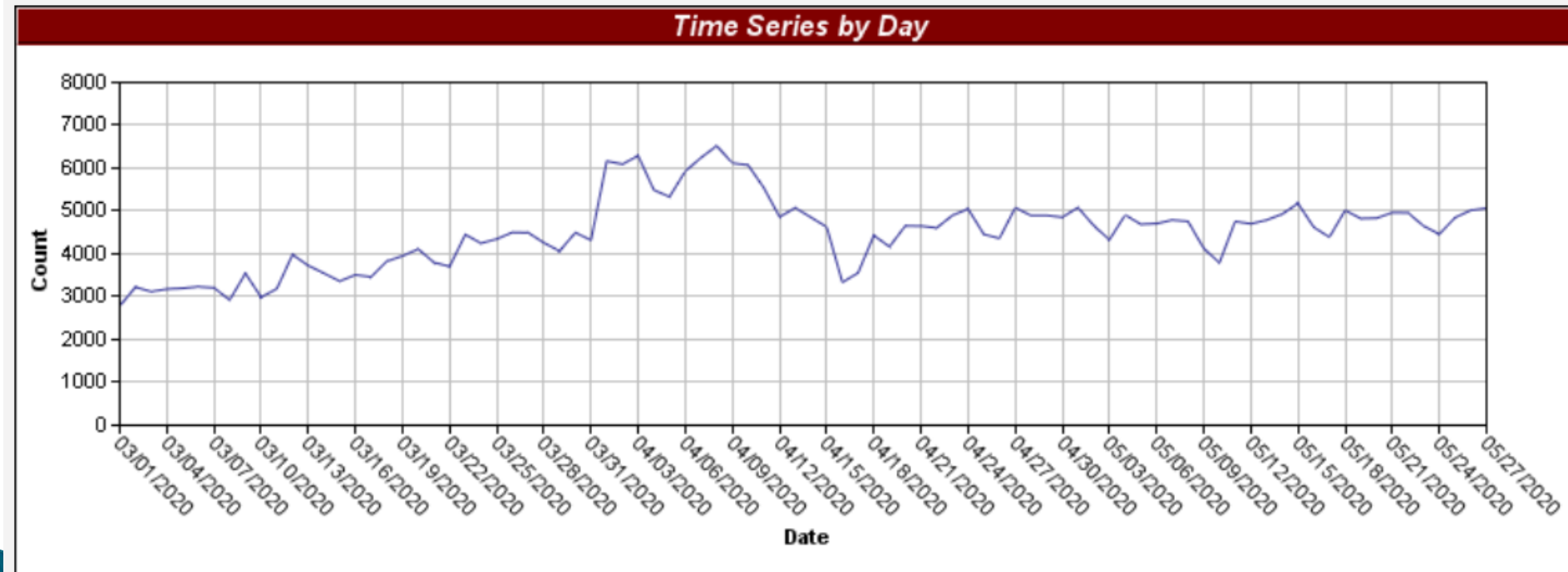

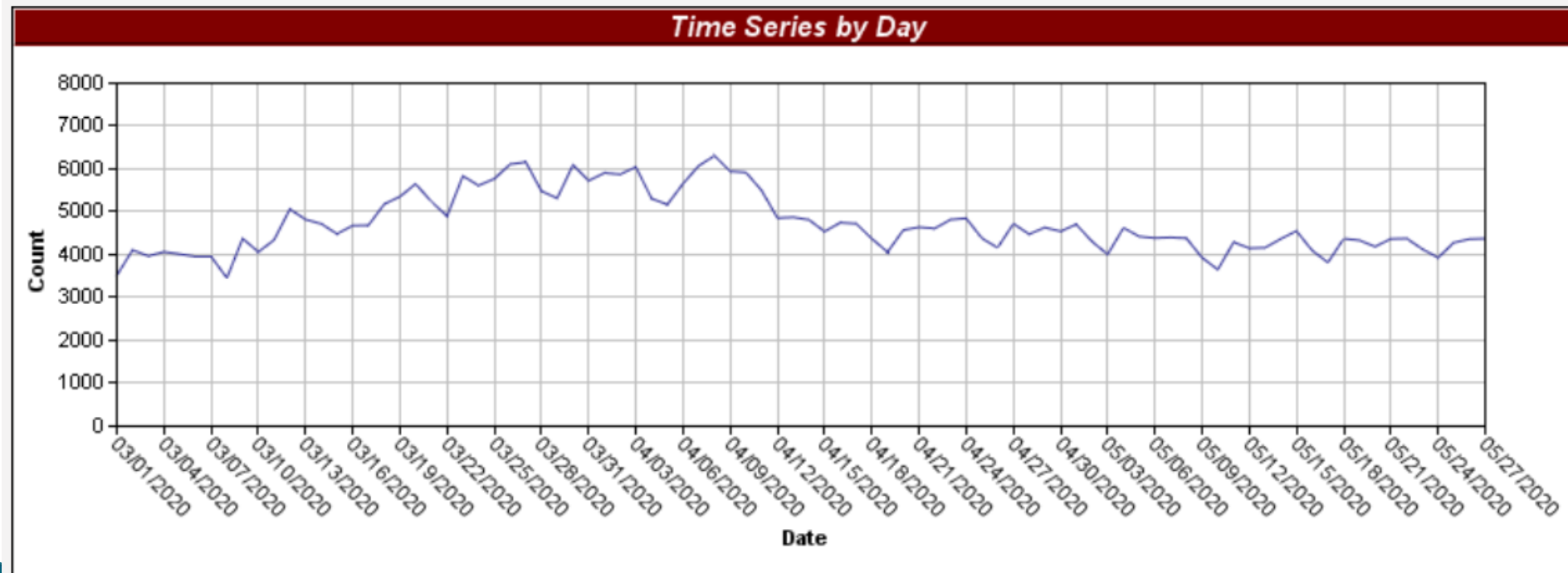

Graphs represent in queue, active or completed calls between the hours of 3/1/2020 and 5/27/2020 11:59:59 PM



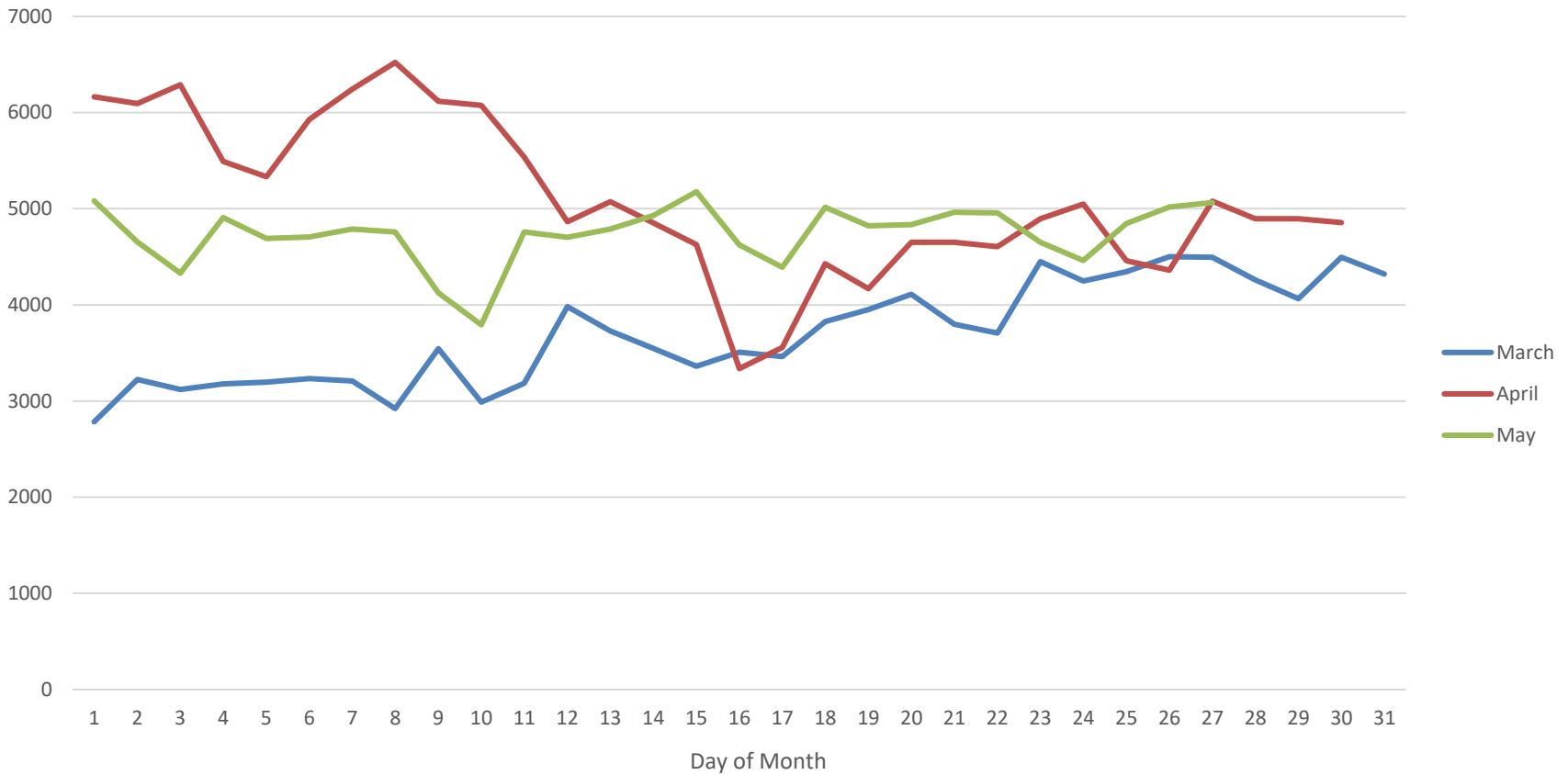

FirstWatch COVID-19 Combined Calls Month over Month



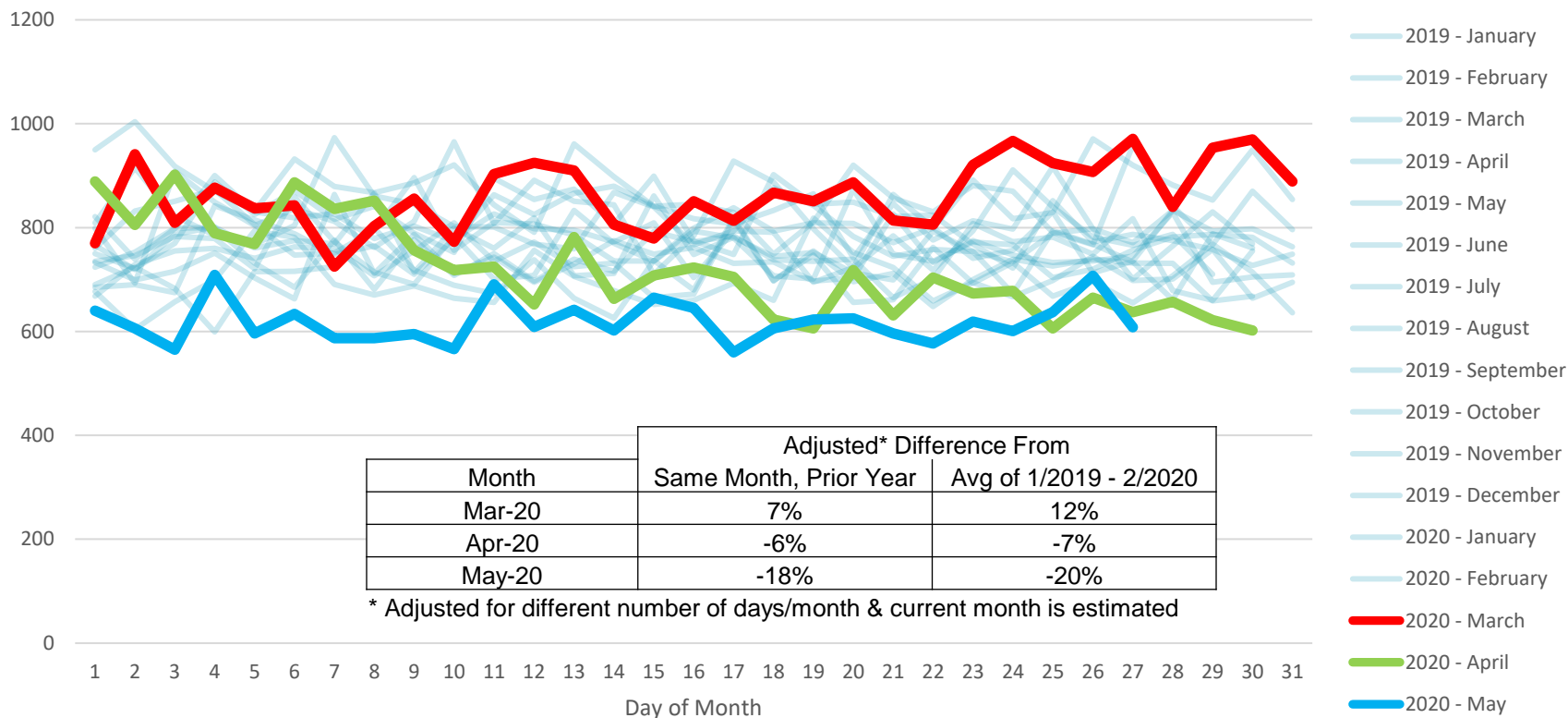
Flu Respiratory Calls

Respiratory Symptoms Call Volume by Year and Month

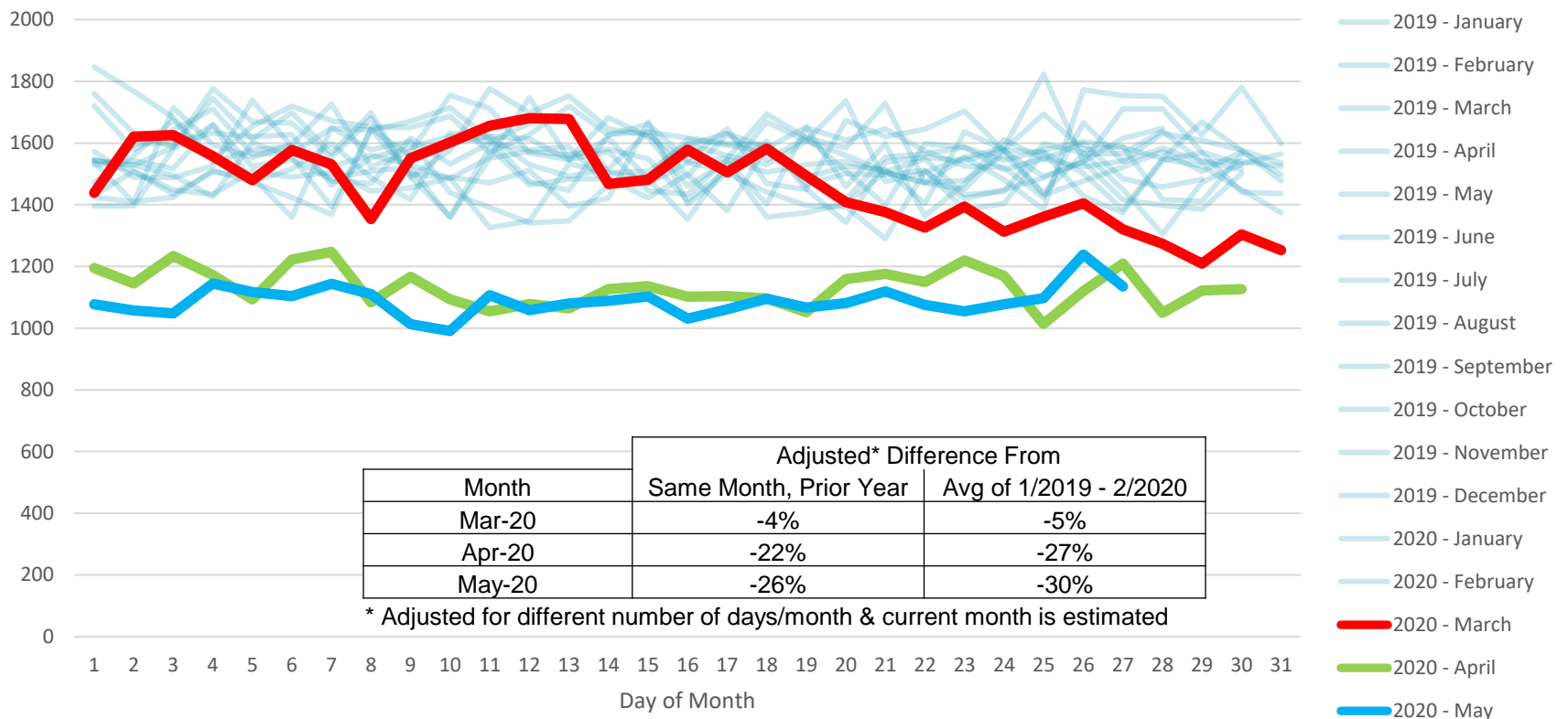


Flu Non-Resp Calls
